Martial Arts at Ruckleigh- September 2022

Dear Parent/ Guardian,

Your child will be taking part in the martial arts sessions at Ruckleigh school. The information in this letter will cover most of the necessary information but if you have any questions, please feel free to contact me using the information above.

Fees

Payment for these sessions is collected half termly in advance (at a cost of £6 per session). Letters will be sent out to existing parents in August and will be available at school prior to the first session for newcomers. Due to difficulties collecting payments in the past, children who are not registered and up to date with payments by the set deadline will not be permitted to attend the sessions. If this is the case, I will contact parents to collect their child from school.

Membership

This is your insurance, licence and registration and costs **£25 annually**. I have taken the decision that this amount will be spread over the course of the year on a half termly basis to make it both easier to collect and fairer given the changeable nature of children. This will show as a charge of **£5** on your bill each half term (excluding the last half term to give your annual £25 total). A membership form will also need to be filled in at time of joining. These are available from the instructor, our website and will also be handed out alongside your bill.

Suits

Suits are not a mandatory piece of equipment for the first few weeks. However, if your child would like a suit, they cost £21 and are available direct from the instructors. If you would like one for a birthday or Christmas present, please speak to one of us and we will arrange a pick up point so that the surprise isn't ruined! T-shirts for summer and other equipment are also available.

Belt tests

Belt tests are run in school and cost £20. Your child will be given a letter when they are ready to test. Please bear in mind that your child may not always be ready to test. As they progress, there is a lot more to remember, and it may take them longer to learn the material they require.
